**Circular 9**

**Sub: Completion of 2019-20-W Semester in light of spread of Novel Coronavirus (COVID19).**

Online classes for the Category 'C' courses has already been started from 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020 as approved vide office note cited in the reference. As per the revised academic calendar examination for the category 'C' is scheduled from July 06-08, 2020.

In this regard, the following directions shall come in force with immediate effect.

1. The examinations for the following courses shall be conducted online during July 06-08, 2020 as per the timetable which shall be announced by the DoAA office.

CS251, CY508, CY509, CY510, CY512, EE101, EE204, IC150,  
IC152, IC251, MA506, MA508, ME111, ME213, ME229, ME232,  
ME334, ME352, ME502, ME632, PH506, PH507, PH508.

2. The students who have poor internet connectivity shall be allowed to appear for the examination from campus (class room) on the following terms.
  - a. He/she shall seek necessary approval well in advance to come to the campus for the examination.
  - b. He/she shall be allowed to stay in the campus not more than 03 days for the examination.
3. The examinations for the following courses shall be conducted offline during July 6-8, 2020 as per the timetable which shall be announced by the DoAA office.

4. The following courses require lab components shall be completed “as is where is basis” and evaluated through online examination.
  - a. IC106: Physics Lab
  - b. IC107: Chemistry Lab
  
5. The following courses require physical presence of students on campus. The IUGC shall propose a suitable methodology for the completion of these courses.
  - a. EE251: EE Lab I (Electrical Machines Lab)
  - b. EE352: EE Lab III
  - c. EE171: Independent Project
  - d. EE371: Independent Project
  
6. The following lab courses where only 20% of the lab component is pending shall resume online by the course instructors and evaluated through online examination/viva.
  - a. CY513: Physical Chemistry Lab
  - b. CY514: Organic Chemistry Lab
  - c. PH510: Experimental Laboratory
  - d. ME101: Engineering and Machine Drawing
  - e. ME110: Machine Drawing
