### Notice

**Sub:** Admission procedure and academic session for 2020-21-M semester due to COVID-19 situation.

Due to the prevailing situation, the admission and academic session for 2020-21-M semester will be conducted as follows.

1. The academic session for 2020-21-M semester shall be held online as per the academic calendar.
2. Existing students who are not able to carry on with online mode of education due to internet bandwidth or other related issues shall be allowed for semester drop on request basis.
3. Admission for BTech and MSc for 2020-21-M semester shall be deferred and academic session for these programs shall be proposed later based on the JoSAA and JOAPS schedule.
4. For the admission of MTech and PhD for 2020-21-M semester, following procedure shall be in place.
  - a. Candidates shall be offered admission to the respective programs on provisional basis (including admission under ASEAN fellowship). The admission shall be confirmed after physical verification of all applicable certificates and testimonials.
    - i. Students who are not able to join the institute in 2020-21-M semester due to the lack of IT infrastructure and the movement restrictions shall be given a deferment of their admission by a semester to join in 2020-21-W semester, if they request so.
  - b. Registration process shall be carried out online on 27 July 2020. Classes shall commence as scheduled (28 July 2020), through online mode. While it is not mandatory for the students to come to campus, students shall be allowed to come to campus, on request basis, subject to the availability of accommodation with social distancing norms in place and other guidelines.
  - c. Students eligible for institute fellowship shall be paid with the fellowship as per the standard terms.
  - d. Students who are not be able to submit the proof of eligibility at the time of admission shall not be paid with fellowship until they submit the required documents. However, their fellowship from the date of admission shall be paid as arrears once they provide all testimonials for verification.
5. The following core courses shall not be offered in 2020-21-M semester, as they require physical presence of students.
  - a. EE351 - Electrical Engineering Lab – II (2 Credits)
  - b. ME371 - Mechanical Engineering Lab I (3 Credits)
  - c. ME372 - Mechanical Engineering Lab II (3 Credits)

To balance the credit load for 2020-21-M semester and enable the students to register for the above-mentioned courses at a later semester, following is proposed.

- a. Students required to take any of the aforementioned courses, are advised to register for an additional DE/OE course.
